Rules and Regulations for Student Participating in the Trip to Football Camp

1. On the day of the trip, all students must report to the Grand Street Campus main entrance on August 22nd, 2007 at 7:30 a.m. to board the bus. Refunds will not be given to students who miss the bus.
2. Items permitted on the bus; pillow, blanket, food (no glass), Walkman, videos and cassettes (the bus has a VCR and DVD deck).
3. It is recommended that students do not bring spending money for the trip, there is no need for it. It is also recommended that students bring pre-paid out of state telephone cards to call home.
4. SWIMMING AND OTHER WATER ACTIVITIES WILL BE PROHIBITED ON THIS TRIP.
5. Chaperones and camp security guards will strictly enforce a nightly student curfew of 10:30 p.m.
6. You must safeguard your personal belongings. The Department of Education, the school or its employees will not be held responsible for lost or stolen property.
7. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and cigarettes are prohibited at all times.
8. Students caught disobeying any rules will be suspended upon return to school, and may not be able to attend graduation exercises. In cases of extreme disruption, your parent will be notified and you may be sent home. The parent will incur all additional expenses resulting from extreme disruption.
10. In the event of an injury or emergency:
 - If you are injured, notify one of the Coaches at Camp
 - If you should need to go to the hospital, one of the coaches will be assigned to accompany you and your parent will be contacted.
 - It is expected that each student will behave properly and not engage in inappropriate behavior that may lead to the student's arrest. However, if a student is arrested, a coach should be notified immediately. The group leader will select a coach to accompany the student to the Police station, and telephone the parent.
