SAFETY PLAN FOR 2007 FOOTBALL CAMP

The following Safety measures for Football Camp in Starrucca, PA will be implemented:

- Parental Consent Forms will be issued prior to the trip and must be returned with the following information: parent signature, any medical conditions/medications taken, copy of Health Insurance Card, and 2 emergency phone numbers. Confirmation phone calls will also be made to parents to ensure proper information. Original Consent forms will be taken on the trip and copies of all documents will be on file at the school.
- Chaperones will accompany students on all activities. A total of 6 chaperones will be on the trip (4 Teachers, 1 School Aid, and 1 Adult).
- In Case of Emergency:
 - *If a student is hurt, hospitalized, or arrested*, the Head Chaperone (the Head Coach) will designate a Chaperone to accompany the student to the required area. The "Head Chaperone" will immediately contact the Principal (will have cell and/or home phone number) and the Parent's) of the students involved. *In case of arrest*, the Head Chaperone will also contact Legal Aid and Child Welfare Services to make arrangements for a representative to stay with the student.
 - **In the case of extraordinary hot weather conditions, in accordance with the PSAL rules and regulations, all physical activities will cease until conditions are restored to appropriate temperatures.**
- Orientations will be given two weeks prior to the trip to both Chaperones and students. We will review the itinerary, the nightly curfew, the room checks, inappropriate conduct and consequences, and the safety plan. Another orientation will be held at the camp in order to reaffirm all information and review the camp's fire safety plan. The Head Chaperone will have a master key to all rooms and, along with the other chaperones, will check all rooms at and after curfew. In addition, baggage will be searched before and during the trip.
- Items to be brought on the trip will include: Original parental consent forms with all accompanying documentation. Student Alpha List, Medicals will be on file, an ATS roster for all players, cell/home phone number of Principal and designated Assistant Principal, First Aid Kit and latex gloves.
 - **As per PSAL Football Rules 2007: "Each student-athlete must have a current (within one calendar year) medical certificate before the first day of participation (tryouts, practices).**
